This afternoon at 4pm there will be Reflective Space for Remembrance here in the Chapel, ending in time for the Dusk ceremony at the War Memorial at 5pm.

Also today from 2pm – 4.30pm there is an afternoon tea party provided by WI in the Village Institute with community entertainment, and at *Embsay Station* there are re-enactments of soldiers returning home at 1pm and 2.30pm, plus a free vintage bus running between Skipton and Embsay.
